



RULES OF PLAY

 - The Raffle Draw is taking place at the Women's Interval Home of Sarnia-Lambton Inc. at 681 Oxford Street, Sarnia, Ontario, Friday, May 10th, 2024
 - The maximum number of tickets available will be 300 at a price of \$10 each or 3 for \$25.
 - Winner does not have to be present to claim the prize.
 - Winner must agree to allow the use of their name.
 - Purchasers of stub tickets must legibly write their information on the stub.
 - The winner will be notified by phone and their name and or ticket number publicly posted on Facebook.
 - Purchasers must be over the age of 18 to play.
 - Problem Gambling Hotline 1-888-230-3505 must be in all advertisements, posters and on the rules of play.
 - The prize is an 8-day, 7-night stay at the Georgian Manor in Collingwood, Ont., worth \$3,000.00.
 - The prize does not include anything above and beyond the accommodation.
 - Board members, executives, and employees of the organization directly involved with charitable gaming, employees of the event location, and prize donors, are ***not*** eligible to win.
 - The tickets will be stored in a ballot box until draw.
